

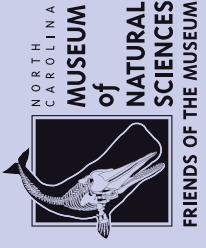

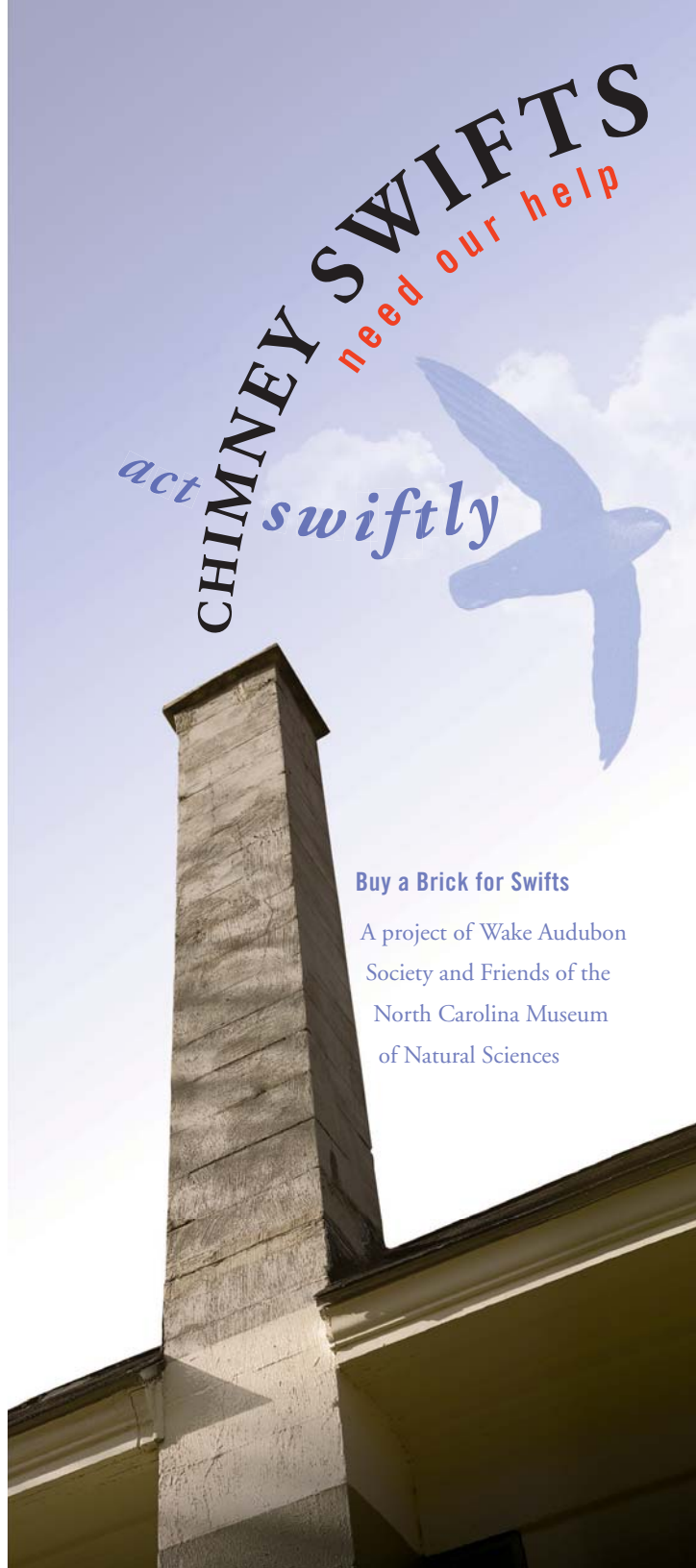

CHIMNEY SWIFTS

For more than 200 years chimney swifts have tied their fate to ours by using chimneys for nesting and roosting. In return, they consume great numbers of flying insects. It's been a successful partnership. But swift populations are declining due, in part, to a shortage of available chimneys.

Chimney swifts need our help.

Wake Audubon Society and Friends of the Museum are partnering to install a permanent Chimney Swift Roost Tower at Prairie Ridge in west Raleigh. This 30-foot chimney will be used by nesting and roosting swifts, and by the scientists who study them. You can help by contributing to our "Buy a Brick for Swifts" campaign.

BUY A BRICK FOR SWIFTS

When you support this campaign with a tax-deductible gift, the inscription of your choice can be set in a brick to be placed in the viewing patio beneath the Chimney Swift Roost Tower.

Funds from the Buy a Brick for Swifts campaign will be used to construct the chimney and viewing patio with benches, support swift research, and provide viewing opportunities of both nesting and roosting swifts. The tower and viewing area will be designed by award-winning architect Frank Harmon.
